## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #1

Week of September 22, 2025

Hi Everyone!

This is our first update to the community regarding the Placerville Drive Pedestrian Connectivity Project. Construction started on Friday September 19, 2025, and these updates will continue to be sent via email to any interested parties and posted on the City of Placerville's website to keep the community up to date on the status of this project. Thanks in advance for everyone's understanding and patience during construction.

### Current Period

- Daytime work for the upcoming week will include:
  - Crews will start underground utility potholing on the west side of Placerville Drive
  - Saw cutting and demolition starting at Helmrich Lane and working to the north
  - Subgrade preparation and aggregate base placement for concrete operations
- Nighttime work for the upcoming week will include:
  - Grinding operations will take place on Monday 9/22/25 from 8:00pm to 5:00am.
  - **Contractor will perform extensive sweeping and clean-up work following the asphalt grinding but is expected that there will be dust the following day – Please keep speeds down**
- Businesses near the project site and their access will remain open during all stages of construction.

### Following Period

- **DAY WORK** – Daytime work operations will include:
  - The Contractor will continue demolition, subgrade preparation and aggregate base placement for concrete operations
  - The Contractor will start forming and pouring the curb, gutter, sidewalk and driveways
- **NIGHT WORK** – No planned night work for the following week.

### Important Information

Traffic control measures will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians through the work areas, but there may be some minor delays. Traffic will be shifted to the east side of Placerville Drive as the Contractor works on the west side of the project.
