### **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #11**

Week of November 28, 2025

#### Hi Everyone!

This is our weekly update to the community regarding the Placerville Drive Pedestrian Connectivity Project. Construction started on Friday September 19, 2025, and these updates will continue to be sent via email to any interested parties and posted on the City of Placerville's website to keep the community up to date on the status of this project. Thanks in advance for everyone's understanding and patience during construction.

#### **Current Period**

- Daytime work for the upcoming week will include (weather dependent):
  - Complete preparation and clean up for final asphalt overlay
  - Complete final profile grind and asphalt overlay on Wednesday December 3, 2025
    - This work is anticipated to occur from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Only one southbound traffic lane of will be provided on Placerville Drive between US 50 and Armory Drive.

      Northbound traffic will be routed through a detour to Fair Lane to Ray Lawyer Drive.
  - Adjust utilities to grade
- No nighttime work planned for the upcoming week
- Businesses near the project site and their access will remain open except on December 3, 2025, from approximately 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm, the paving operation will be on the west side of Placerville Drive. During this time, access to the driveways on the west side of Placerville Drive and Helmrich Lane will be restricted. Please plan accordingly.

#### **Following Period**

- <u>DAY WORK</u> Daytime work operations will include (weather dependent):
  - Install final striping, pavement markings and stamped thermoplastic
  - A few long lead items will be completed at a later date but will have minimal impact to vehicular traffic on Placerville Drive
    - Install storm drain pipe lining
    - Install Radar Feedback Sign and Flashing Beacon System for the crosswalk

#### **Important Information**

During the final asphalt overlay work the Contractor will have a detour route will in place to reduce vehicular traffic on Placerville drive and access to the local businesses will be limited.
