## Transportation Permit

### Permit Restrictions and Conditions – Effective 07/15/2022

- 1) Transportation permits are required within the City of Placerville when a vehicle and/or vehicle load is larger than the following dimensions: 8'-6" in width, 14' in height, 40' in length (single unit) or 65' in length (combo unit), gross weight 80,000 pounds maximum, single axle 20,000 pounds, axle group less than 8'-6" between outer axles 34,000 pounds, axle group more than 8'-6" between outer axles see the CVC weight chart per CVC 35551.(a) and per CVC 35551.(c) and (e).
- 2) Payment for permit(s) shall be paid for at the time of issuance. Permit requests and payment shall be made via phone (530) 642-5250 or in person/mailed at the following address:

- 3) Permit is the property of the City of Placerville and must be surrendered upon demand to a law enforcement officer or representative of the City.
- 4) No moving the day before or after a legal holiday and no moving on weekdays from 7:00 am until 9:00 am and 4:00 pm until 6:00 pm.
- 5) No moving during rain or fog, when visibility is less than 1000'.
- 6) Permit or a copy thereof shall be carried on the permitted vehicle, along with a copy of these conditions.
- 7) Regardless of whether an annual permit has been issued, a trip permit shall be obtained for route verification of all loads larger than 12' wide, 95' long, or 15' high. If the truck requires Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982 (STAA) approval, the truck will only be allowed to travel on approved STAA routes.
- 8) Signs – All signs shall have 4" minimum block letters.
  - OVER WIDTH – If over 8'6" wide, there shall be a "WIDE LOAD" or "OVER SIZE" sign on front and rear of vehicle. If load is more than 12' wide, there will be a pilot car to the front and rear bearing additional signs of the same legend.
  - OVER LENGTH – If over 65' long there shall be a "LONG LOAD" or "OVER SIZE" sign on front and rear of vehicle. If over 95' long, there will be a pilot car to the front and rear bearing additional signs of the same legend.

- FRONT OVERHANG – If the load extends more than 3' beyond the front bumper of the vehicle, and “EXCESSIVE FRONT OVERHANG” or “OVERSIZE” sign must be displayed at the rear of the vehicle through intersections and around corners.
- 9) It shall be the responsibility of the permittee to check for impaired clearances and to bypass or arrange clearance at such locations.
  - 10) If loaded dimensions exceed 14'-6" in width, police notification is required for escort. Please contact the Police Department Non-Emergency number at (530) 642-5280.
  - 11) If towing a mobile home, permittee certifies that all zoning permits have been obtained upon application.
  - 12) The permittee agrees to repair at his/her expense and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, any damage to the highway, roads or structures. Work repair may be done by City forces at the option of the City Engineer. The cost is to be borne by the permittee.
  - 13) The permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury or property damage which may occur through any act or omission of the permittee when acting under this permit, and in the event any claim is made against the City, or any department, officer, or employee there of, through, by reason of, or in connection with any such act or omission. Permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them and each of them harmless from such claim, listing the City of Placerville as additionally insured.
  - 14) Approval of this permit does not grant permission to stand or park in the public right-of-way.
  - 15) Trucks route restrictions are as follows:
    - Main Street: From September 1st through February 15<sup>th</sup> or when holiday lights are hanging across the roadway.
    - Schnell School Road – El Dorado Trail Bridge is 15'- 5" (height).
    - Other locations similar to those stated above. Permittee is responsible for verifying height and weight limitations.
    - During the City’s holiday season moratorium for construction projects.
