### A Message From the City Manager

In 2010 and 2016 the City passed Sales Tax Measures to assist in providing betters roads, water, sewer, and storm drain services. These Measures added just over \$3 million a year to fix and improve our roads and pipes. The first couple of years after 2016 were a little slow as we geared up to implement construction projects to implement these funds. In 2020, we began seeing the fruits of our efforts. This past year's completed projects include Spring Street and a start on Mosquito Road, Upper Broadway other smaller water and sewer improvements. Unfortunately the weather hit us before we could finish Mosquito Road. However, once the weather clears, Mosquito Road will be the first project we do this Spring. Projects for the upcoming year include Mosquito Road Park and Ride. The recent improvements to our waterlines are saving 443 acre feet of water that was previously lost due to leaking waterlines thereby saving \$121,224 annually. We will continue to repair our streets and pipes on an annual basis as funding is available. We continue to look for all available grants to help us do more. Thank you to our Measures H/L Sales Tax Committee, which has been a great advocate and watchdog for this funding. I look forward to continued progress in providing better roads, water, and sewer pipes to our great community.
