# 7. MEASURE L FUND BUDGET LIQUIDATION AND APPROPRIATION (Ms. Neves)

- 3. Approving a \$100,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund for the Storm Drain Replacement at the Intersection of Broadway and Schnell School Road (CIP #42004).
