

RESOLUTION NO. 8677

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PLACERVILLE ADOPTING THE NUMBER OF EACH TYPE OF
COMMERCIAL CANNABIS BUSINESS THAT SHALL BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE
IN THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH
ORDINANCE NUMBER 1694**

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville adopted ordinance number 1694 on October 9, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.28.080 of that ordinance states that the number of each type of commercial cannabis business that shall be permitted to operate in the City shall be established by resolution by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance and this resolution is only intended to create a maximum number of commercial cannabis businesses that may be issued permits to operate in the City under each category. Nothing in this resolution or the ordinance creates a mandate that the City Council must issue any or all of the commercial cannabis business permits if it is determined that the applicants do not meet the standards which are established in the application requirements or further amendments to the application process or that the City Council upon further deliberation determines that the issuance of any or all commercial cannabis business permits will impact the public safety, welfare or other policy concerns which may be detrimentally affected by the issuance of these permits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby establishes the following Cannabis Business type and maximum number of businesses that may be allowed within the City of Placerville:

1. No more than three (3) cannabis retailers, store front or non-store front as defined by ordinance, may operate within the City of Placerville at any one time and shall be issued a permit by the City of Placerville.
2. No more than three (3) testing laboratories, facilities, or entities that offer or perform tests of cannabis or cannabis products.
3. For purposes of this resolution and Ordinance Number 1694, a Microbusiness shall be considered a cannabis retailer as stated in item 1 above.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on November 13, 2018, by Councilmember Clerici, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Acuna. The motion was passed by the following vote:
