

EL DORADO ARTS COUNCIL IS NOW ARTS AND CULTURE EL DORADO


Founded in 1984 by a group of passionate arts supporters and incorporated as a not-for-profit organization in 1989 as El Dorado Arts Council, Arts and Culture El Dorado is celebrating its 35th Anniversary year with a new name and new emphasis on the cultural aspects that make El Dorado County a special place to live, work, and visit: Visual arts, music, theater, literary arts, dance, history, heritage, preservation, architecture, agriculture, and forestry.

This mission is achieved by targeted programs and services, a vibrant gallery exhibition series, and a focus on initiatives that support and sustain the cultural life of the region.





GENESIS OF PROJECT:

In April 2017, Arts Council completed a Cultural Master Plan for El Dorado County. This plan contained 22 recommendations and proposed partnerships, resulting from an 18-month process that included review of 25 reports, maps, plans and other foundational documents, over 100 interviews, and extensive research into the cultural assets in El Dorado County.



One recommendation from the Cultural Master Plan was to consider a potential Cultural District for downtown Placerville, and feasibility studies were undertaken.

During the feasibility study, as the consultant engaged in interviews (110 in all), it was recommended that we further test the potential of a Cultural District. We began to develop a roadmap that included space for performing and visual arts, a cultural community center that would serve as a true community resource, an arts “flex space,” offices for Arts and Culture El Dorado, residential apartments for artists, and a unique Arts & Agriculture building.




PROPOSED REUSE






The space will also house small performances and pop-ups, talks, receptions, play readings, music events, and other community activities designed to enliven downtown Placerville.





Book clubs




CONFIDENCE AND EMIGRANT JANE – FIRST FLOOR

The second floors of both buildings will become artist studio apartments. Residents of these live-work spaces will take shifts as gallery attendants in the Confidence Lab gallery downstairs.


CONFIDENCE & EMIGRANT JANE BUILDINGS


ARTIST STUDIO APARTMENTS



HISTORIC CHARACTER OF BUILDINGS

An important consideration in the concept development process was the desire to bring these iconic structures back into contemporary use as a vibrant part of the daily lives of people, and be good stewards of the buildings.

The historic character of the buildings will remain the same. The concentration of professional services has been on reviewing the condition of the buildings, the program requirements, and the funds required to bring them up to code.



BUSINESS CLIMATE IN DOWNTOWN PLACERVILLE

The proposed adaptive reuse of Confidence and Emigrant Jane represents Phase 1 of a Cultural District on historic Main Street. The cultural connectivity created by the Cultural District will undoubtedly attract residents and out-of-town visitors alike, drawn to the diversity of cultural offerings but also eager to investigate the shops, galleries, restaurants, and other amenities nearby.



FINANCIAL PLAN AND BUILDING OWNERSHIP

Financing of required structural improvements and tenant improvements:

- Current cost estimate is \$3.6 million, developed with architects, consultants and subcontractors
- Structure of capital campaign in development
- Prominent community member will serve as Campaign Chair
- All funds will be held by El Dorado Community Foundation and restricted to project costs



Fundraising and building improvement timeline

- Fundraising timeline – Approximately 2 years, beginning upon selection
- Build timeline – Approximately 1 year
- Note: If renovations can be done in phases, timelines could overlap

FINANCIAL PLAN AND BUILDING OWNERSHIP

Funding of maintenance and operations:

- Maintenance: Ongoing maintenance will be covered by revenue from Artist Apartments, Gallery and Office space, in addition to 50% of revenue generated by outside users of Gallery and Arts Flex space.
- Operations: Arts and Culture will manage and operate both buildings.

Ownership: The City of Placerville will continue to own the buildings, on a long-term lease with Arts and Culture El Dorado.
