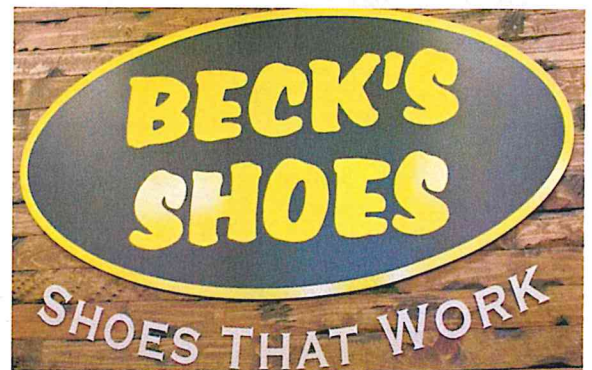

311 - Report an issue to the City



What to report:

- * Potholes / Street Defect
- * Fire Hazard
- * Clogged Storm Drain
- * Sewer Issues
- * Water Leaks
- * Graffiti / Trash
- * Park / Tree Maintenance
- * Signage Issue
- * Unsafe Structure
- * Missed Street Cleaning
- * Damage to Public Property

The purpose and mission of the 311 system is to enable greater efficiency, accountability and transparency of non-emergency services while maintaining the highest possible level of customer service. The list shows some of the types of services you can request using this system at www.cityofplacerville.org.

There are four steps to create a service request ticket:

1. **Log into the system or create an account** – We need you to log in so we know who you are and can respond to you more easily.
2. **Select a Service Type** – Each service request will be routed to the appropriate department or employee at the city.
3. **Create a Request** – Enter the details about your request, including the location of the issue and any photos if available.



4. **Review and Submit** – After describing your request, you can review your request for accuracy. Once you submit your request, it will be linked to your account in the system. You can then log back into the Portal to manage your requests and see the progress of your requests.
