b. Subcommittee Updates

Business Outreach Committee (Miller, Kaiserman, Brown) - The committee reported that they completed two BOV visits since the last meeting. A report has been prepared and will be distributed at the next meeting. Member Brown reviewed the results of the visits with Gold Country Inn and Pat's Carpet. It was requested that staff follow up on those items pertaining to staff.

Tourism Committee (Anderson) – This committee was previously chaired by Member Brent Bumb. Member Anderson agreed to chair the committee. No additional committee members were appointed.

Health and Wellness Committee (Dolly Wager, Debbie Miller, Mickey Kaiserman) - Member Wager is the current chair. Members Wager stated that she has some ideas but has not had time to pursue those yet.

Broadband Committee (Vonderschmitt, Brown) Member Vonderschmitt reported that committee members have been meeting with potential stake holders to participate in a feasibility study. Those meetings were stopped when it was discovered that the County has already done some of the necessary work to complete a feasibility study. Mr. Morris reported on his meeting with the County and their consultant. A handout was distributed showing the potential cost for a fiber to the home infrastructure program. A meeting will be held with the City's consultant, Jeff Christensen of Entry Point on August 29, 2018. Member Wager stated that both Mayor Thomas and her husband Dennis Thomas have expressed interest in this project and are willing to assist. Member Wager also asked to be invited to future meetings.
