## 795 Chamberlain Street – Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 21-01: The Varozza Cottage

Placerville City Council will conduct a public hearing on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 13</u>, <u>2021</u>, <u>6:00 p.m.</u>, to consider an appeal filed by Julie Robinson of the Planning Commission's approval of CUP21-01, a request by applicant Danielle Slater, for property owner Du Troupeau LLC, to operate a two (2) room bed and breakfast establishment within an existing single-family residence constructed in 1916, and located within the Sacramento Street – Chamberlain Street Residential Historic District.


