I am writing with grave concerns about the possibility of a variance (Var) 20-01-PVILLECA LLC that is due to be considered on September 15, 2020 by the Placerville Planning Commission.

I am the Principal of Sierra Elementary School that is located approximately 200 feet from the proposed "Cannabis Business". Based on the location on the map attached to the Public Notice, this proposed "Cannabis Business" is directly on a route many of my students and families use to walk to and from school every day.

I am begging the Planning Commission to consider the safety and welfare of my 465 TK-5th grade students. They do not need to be exposed to a business of this type while coming to school. In addition to the families and unaccompanied students who walk to school daily, we participate in an annual "Walk to School Day" where all of our students meet at the Mosquito Bus Depot and walk together in groups to school. Given the location of the proposed "Cannabis Business" our entire student body as well as staff and parent volunteers would have to walk by this business. I feel that this kind of exposure would be detrimental to my students and ask you to not allow the variance.
