

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-01

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE
PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE
REGARDING EXTERIOR/OUTDOOR LIGHTING

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that exterior lighting associated with existing and new development may negatively impact nearby properties and affect the property values and quality of life of the citizens of Placerville; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that proliferation of exterior lighting throughout the community affects the citizens' ability to enjoy the aesthetic and tranquil observation of the night-time skyline; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that the City's current regulations in regard to exterior/outdoor lighting are vague and ineffective in minimizing the impacts of existing and new development from lighting, thereby affecting the quality of life for the residents of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the City of Placerville authorizes the Acting Community Development Director of the City of Placerville to prepare draft regulations to amend the Zoning Ordinance regarding Exterior/Outdoor Lighting.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the Planning Commission of the City of Placerville held on November 7, 2000, by Commissioner Rivas who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Acuna. The motion carried by general consent of the Planning Commission.
