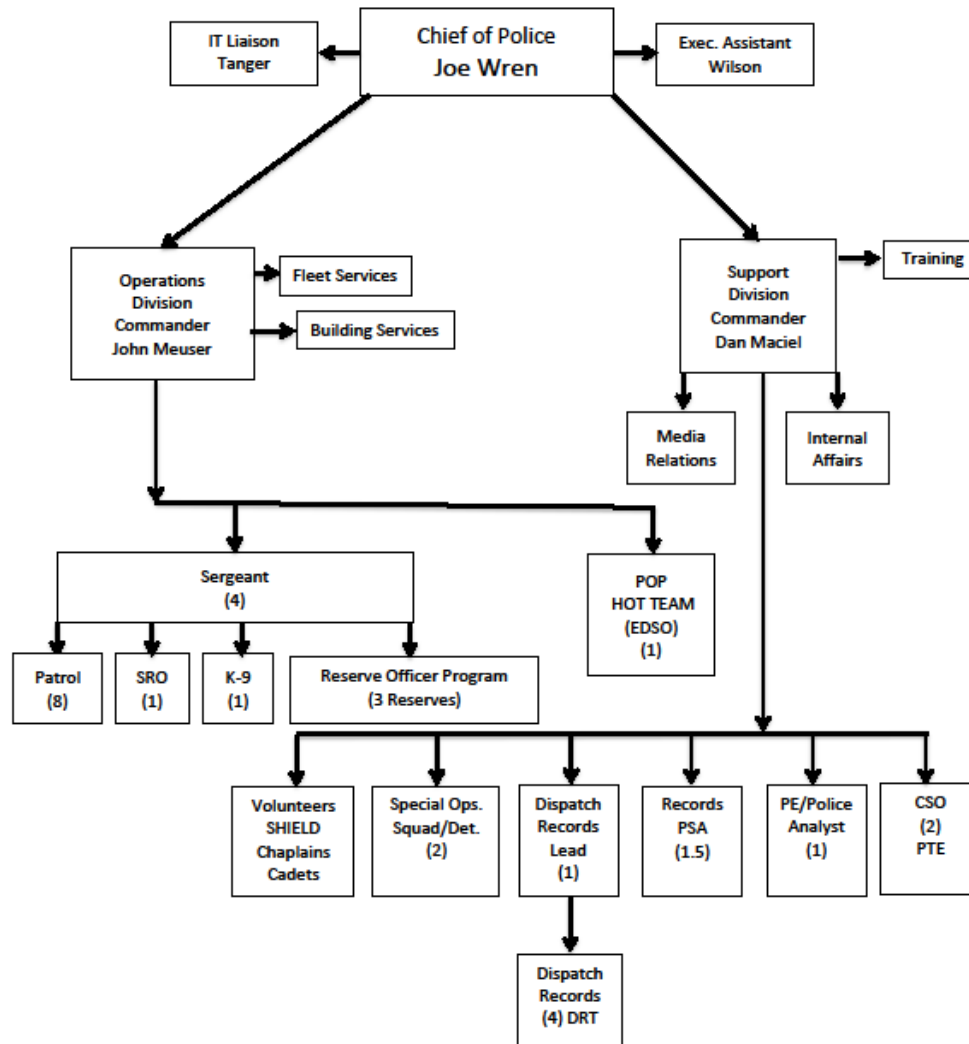

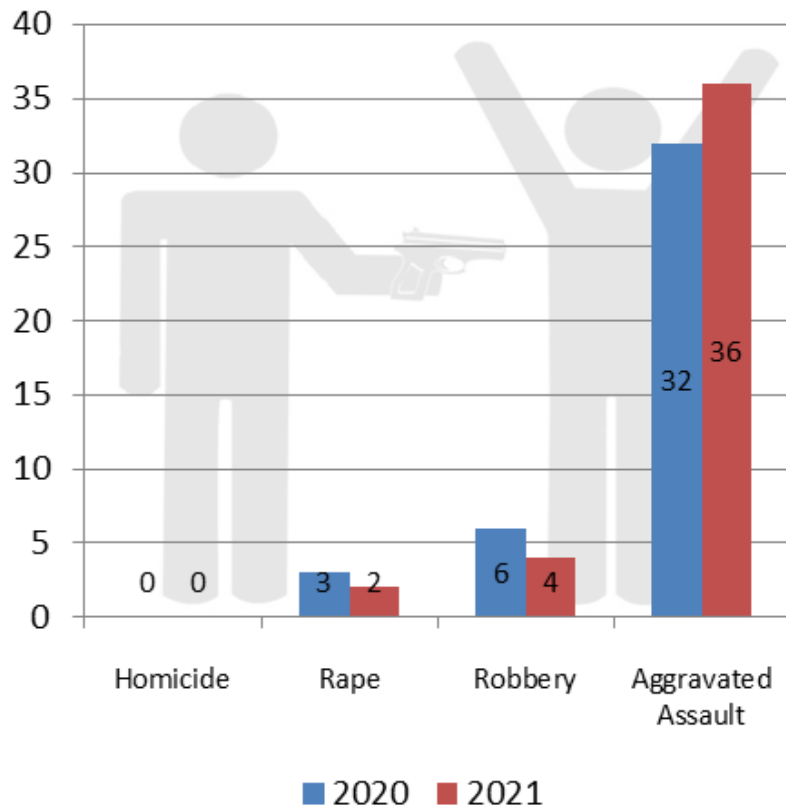

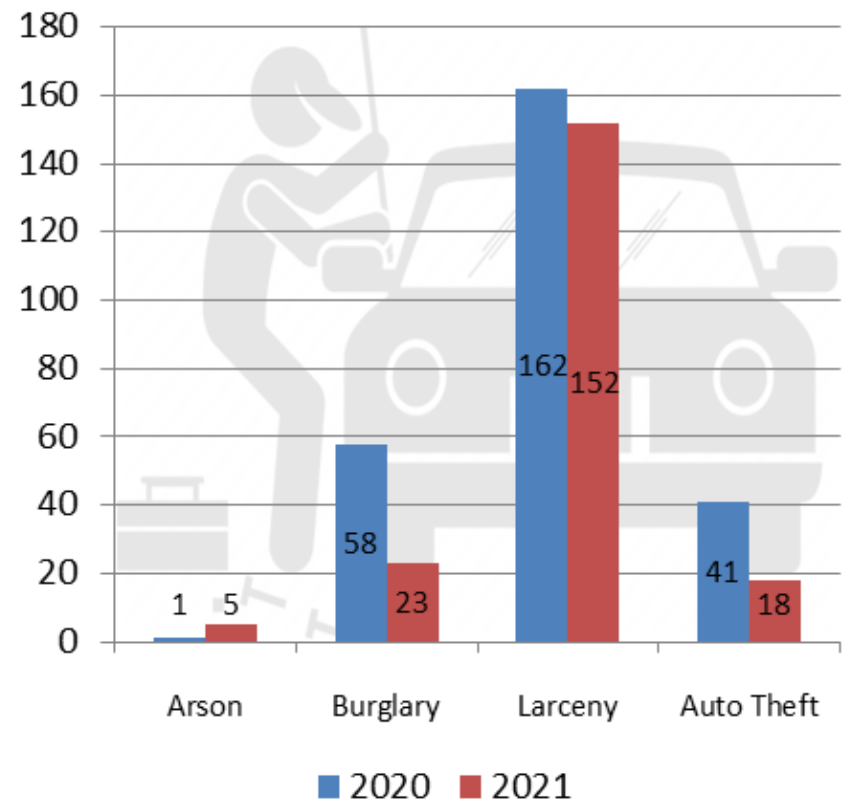

Comparison 2019/2020**

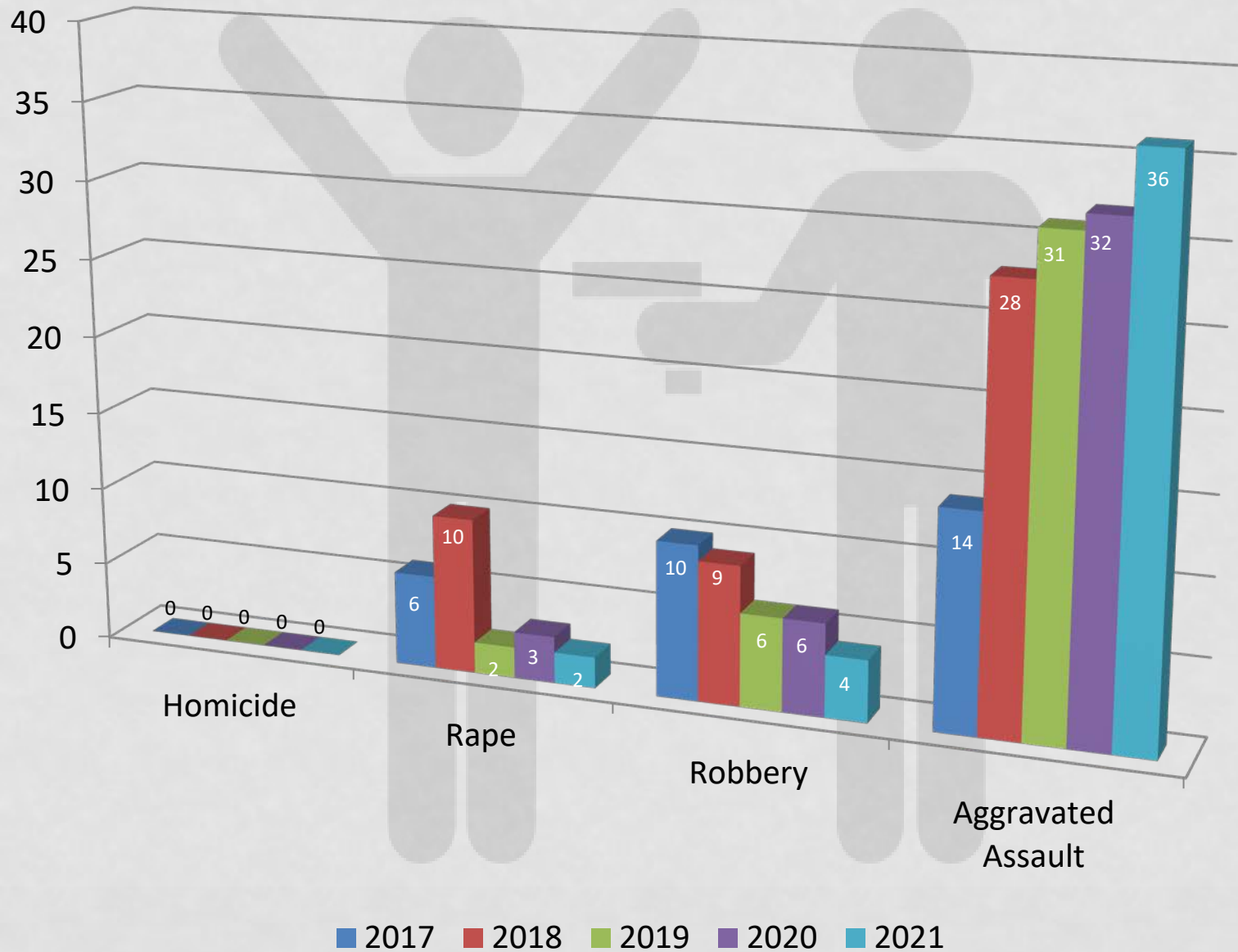

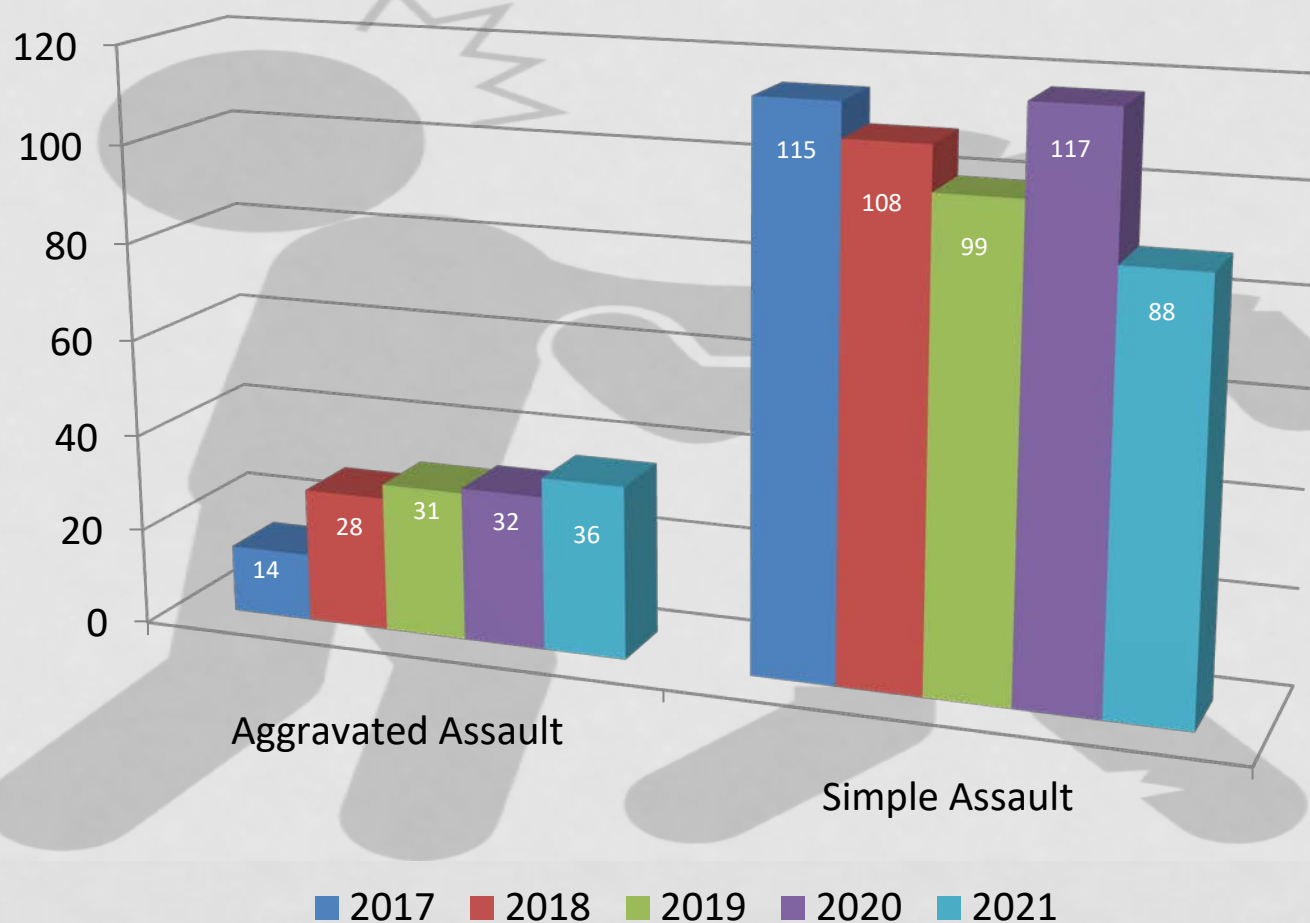

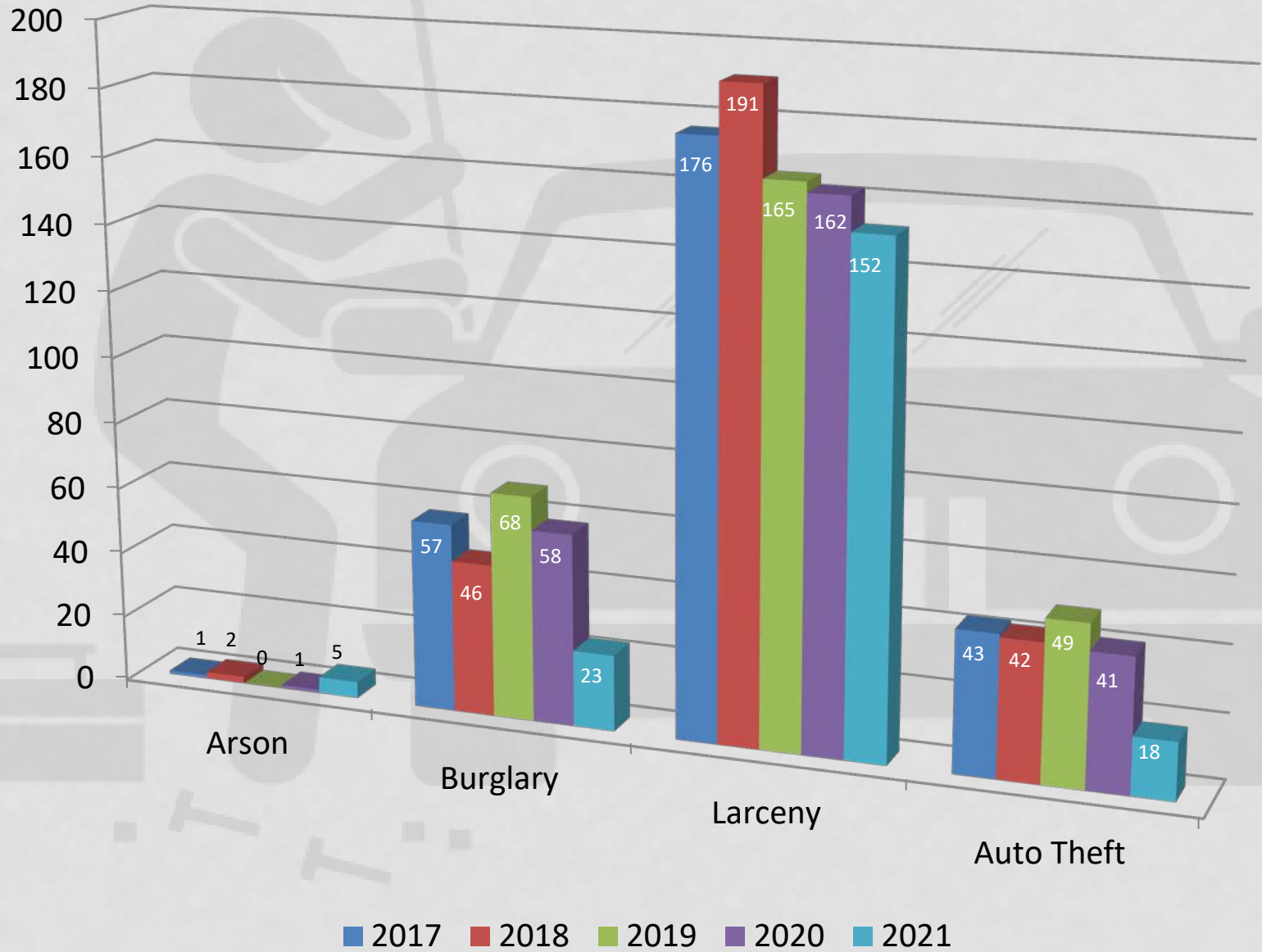

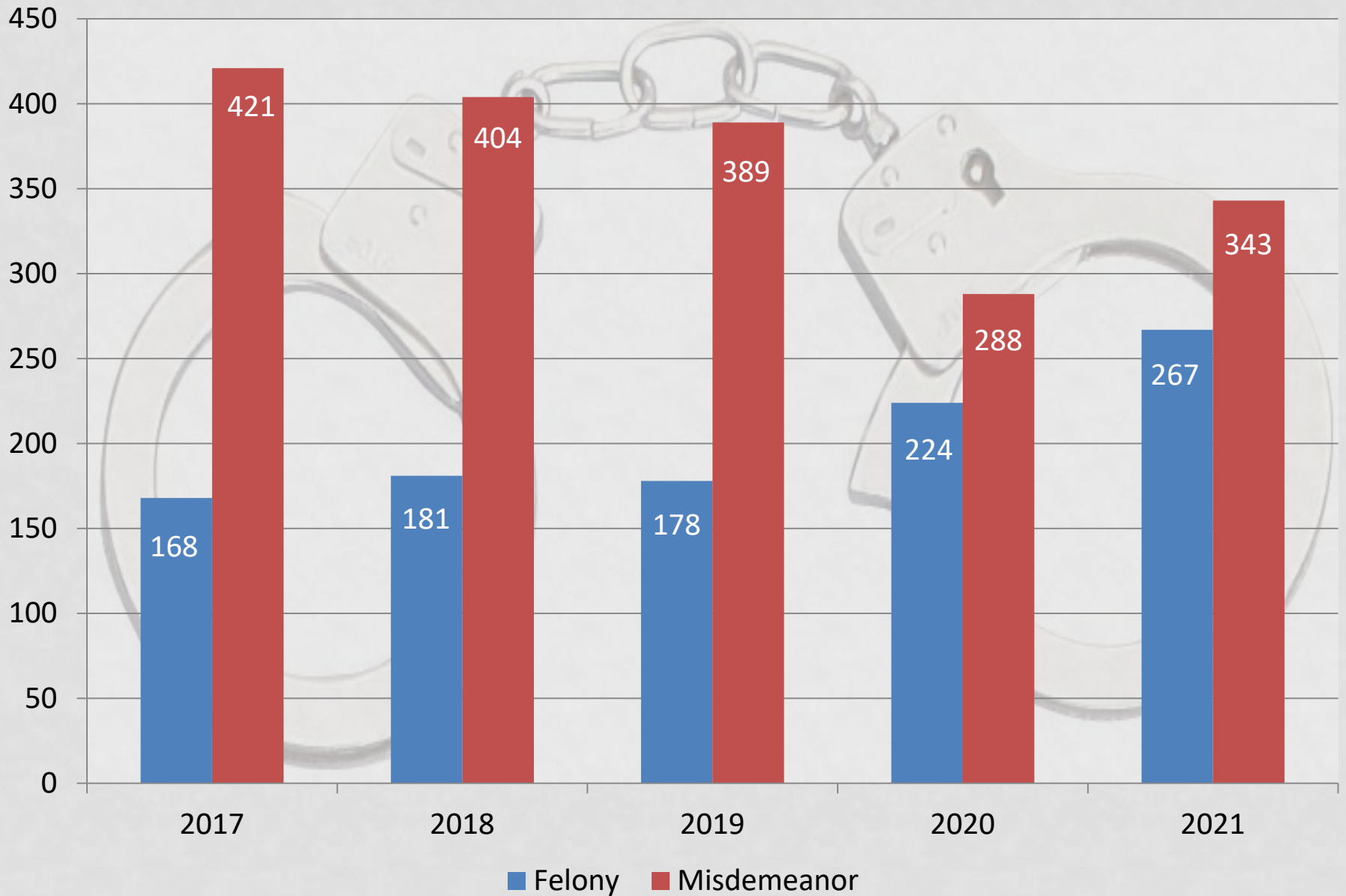
### Aggravated and Simple Assault - 5 Year Comparison



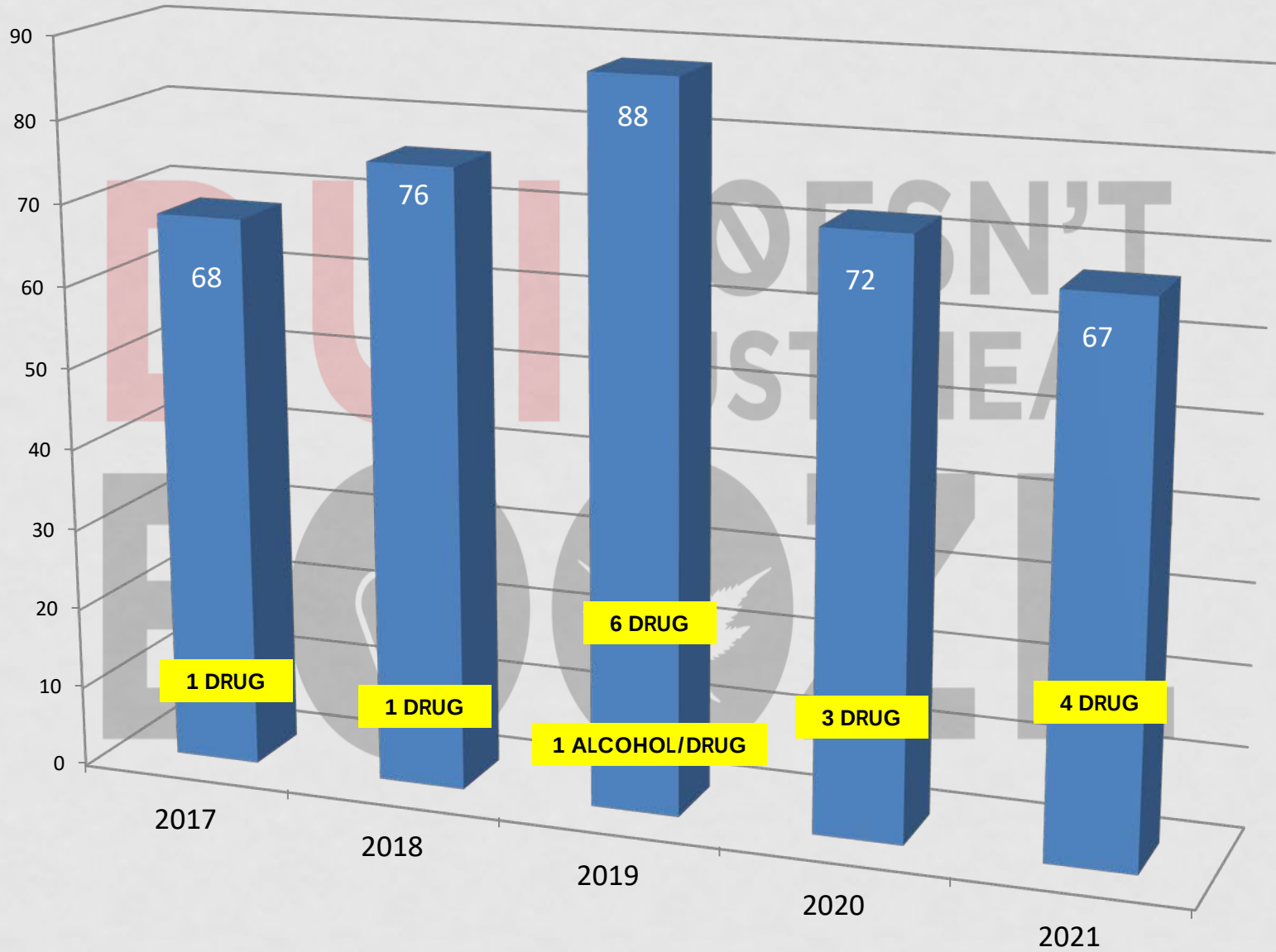

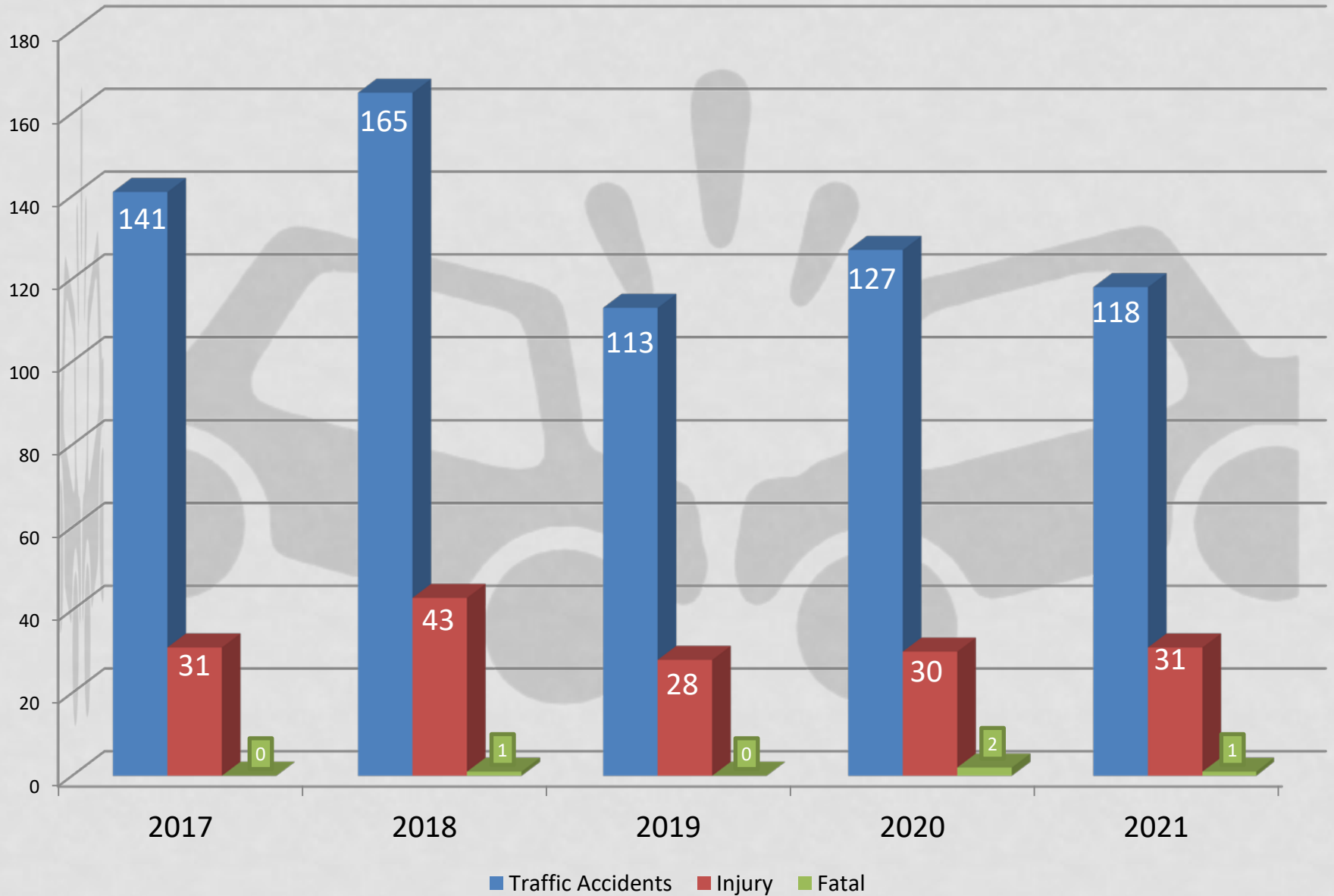
## Arrests - 5 Year Comparison



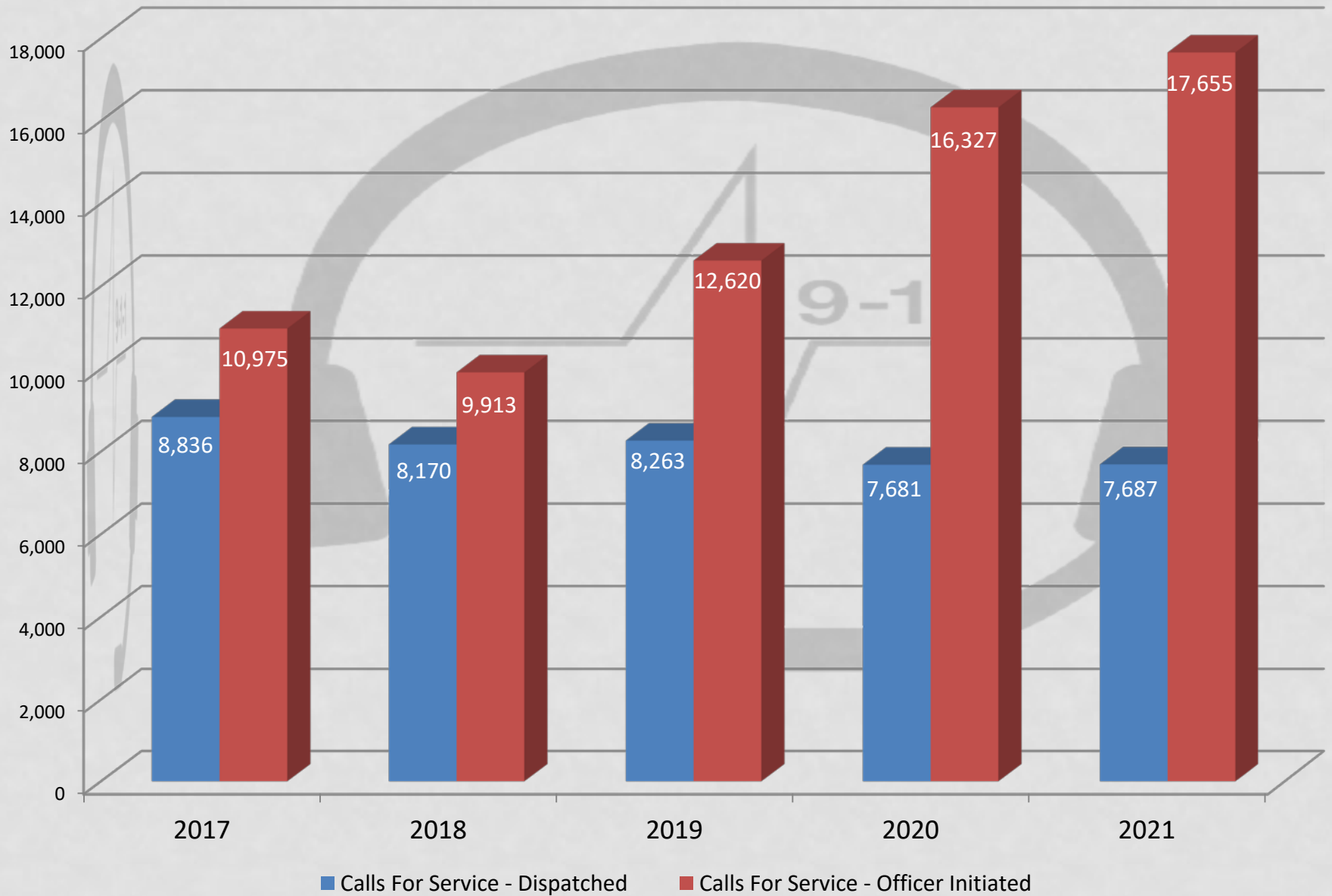
## DUI Arrests - 5 Year Comparison



## Traffic Collisions - Injury - Fatality 5 Year Comparison



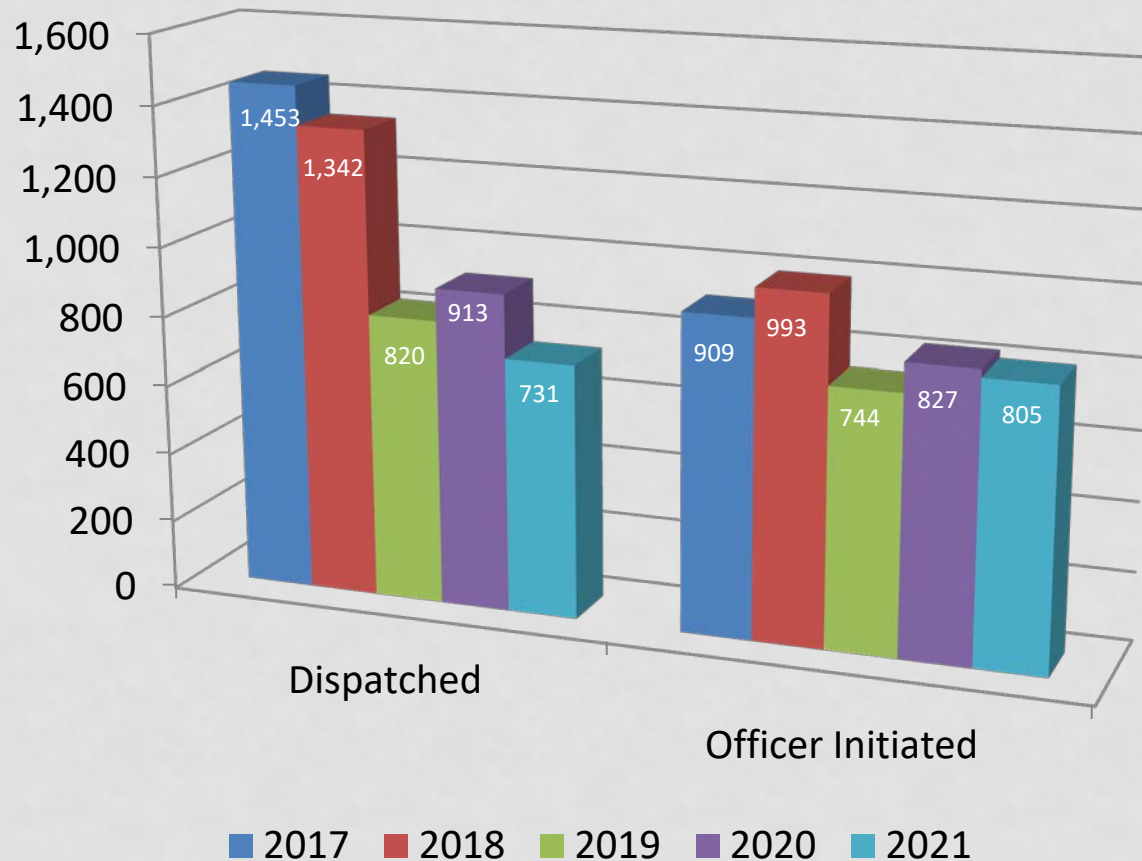
## Calls For Service - 5 Year Comparison



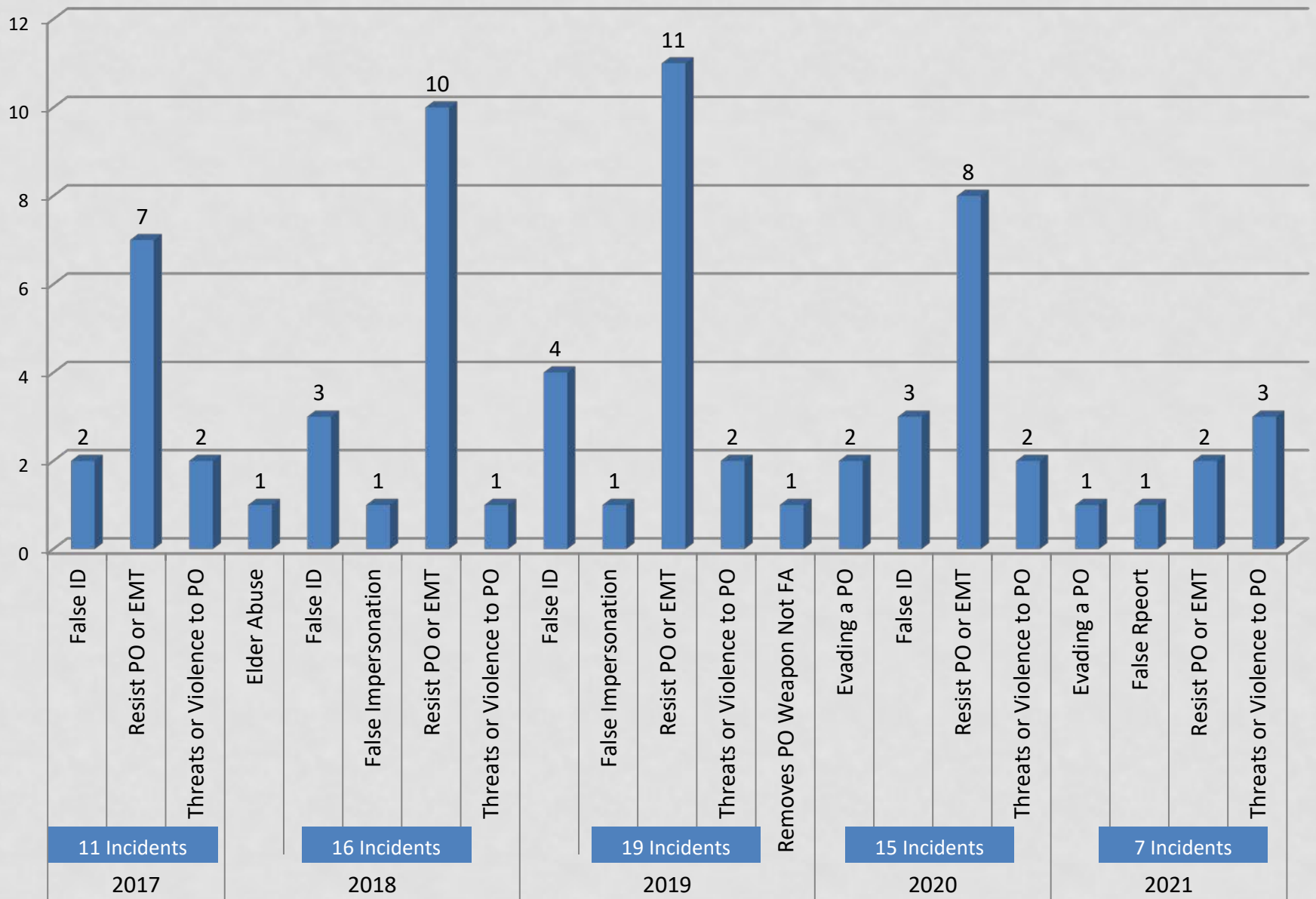

### Transient CFS - 5 Year Comparison



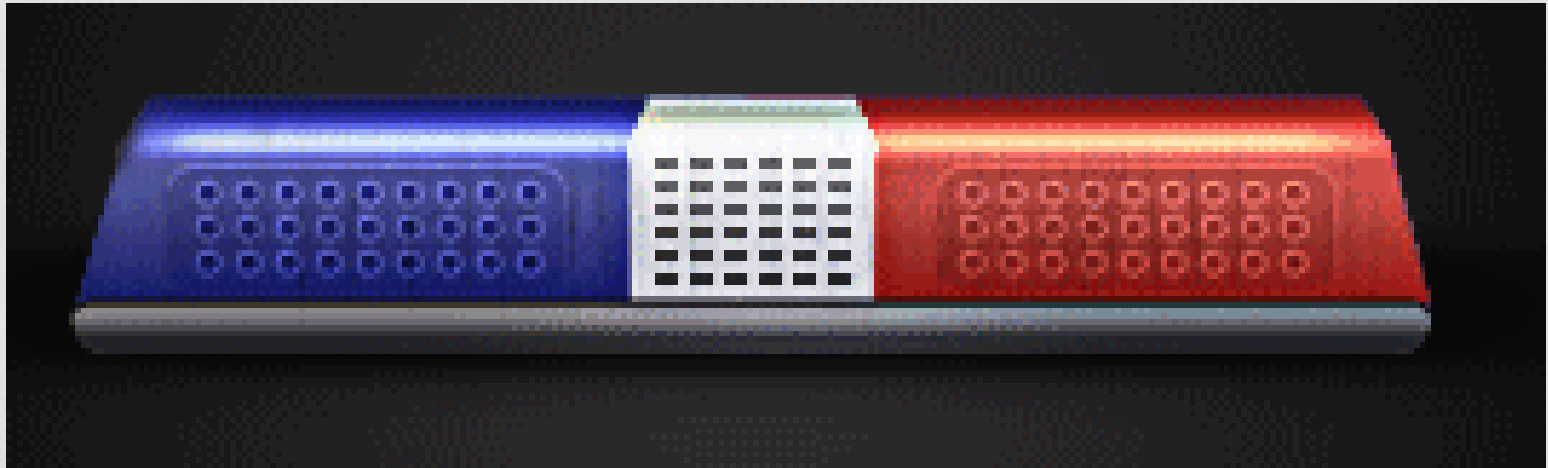
## Obstructing a Police Officer - 5 Year Comparison
