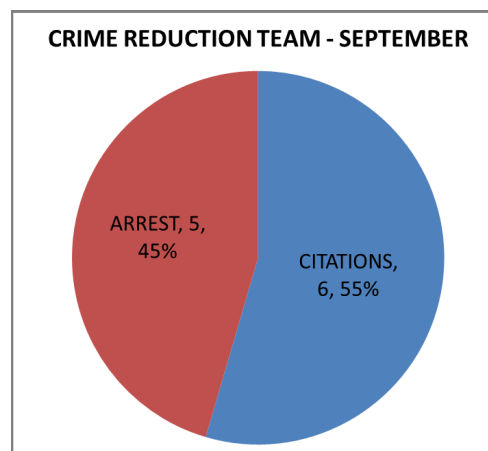


INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-imitated investigations.
