





INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

Investigations 2023 open case load is currently 18. The Crime Reduction Team consists of a sergeant and two detectives to meet the needs of the department and the community.

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-initiated investigations.

Crime Reduction Team and Investigations – Notable Activity

- CRT coordinated with allied agencies and HHS for Upper Broadway Dr. Outreach for the entire month of February. Contacted 55 individuals, with the focus of identifying those that are camping in the area.
- Numerous individuals signed up for the Navigation Center interest list for the Feb 7, 2023 opening of the facility.
- February 27 Start of Broadway Dr. cleanup with Caltrans and CHP. All individuals that were still on the hillside complied with CHP to leave the hillside.
- March 8, 2023 Navigation Center is seeing an average of 4 6 individuals per day in their intake.
 Currently there are 45 individuals in the Navigation Center.
