





INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

Investigations 2023 open case load is currently 21. The Crime Reduction Team consists of a sergeant and two detectives to meet the needs of the department and the community.

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-initiated investigations.

Crime Reduction Team and Investigations – Notable Activity

- CRT contacted 16 individuals, with the focus of identifying those that are camping in the city limits.
- 9 individuals were helped with entry into the Navigation Center.
- 7 individuals were arrested for various charges of under the influence of drugs or alcohol, paraphernalia, vandalism, violation of probation, illegal weapons, and warrants.
- CRT assisted the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office in the Officer Involved Shooting (OIS) that occurred
 on Baco Dr. Our response is part of the Critical Incident Protocol Policy along the El Dorado County
 District Attorney's Office and South Lake Tahoe Police Department.
- Investigations received 10 Child Protective Services (CPS) referrals regarding child abuse allegations.
