INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

Investigations 2023 open case load is currently 27. The Crime Reduction Team consists of a sergeant and two detectives to meet the needs of the department and the community.

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-initiated investigations.

Crime Reduction Team and Investigations – Notable Activity

- 2 Tents with occupants located. Street Outreach and HHSA were present to offer services.
- 5 individuals entered the Navigation Center.
- 7 individuals cited for stolen shopping cart, drugs, and paraphernalia, under the influence of drugs, trespassing, and unlawful camping.
- Total Calls for Service to Government Buildings for September - 48
