





INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

Investigations 2023 open case load is currently 14. The Crime Reduction Team consists of a sergeant and two detectives to meet the needs of the department and the community.

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-initiated investigations.

Crime Reduction Team and Investigations – Notable Activity

- CRT coordinated with allied agencies and HHS for the Upper Broadway Dr. Outreach. A comprehensive count of 31 homeless individuals informing them of the incoming Navigation Center.
- Assisted two habitual transient offenders in reuniting with family and relocated outside of the county.
- Updated trespass letters with businesses on upper Broadway Dr.
- Assisted Officer in locating a robbery suspect.
- Assisted Probation in locating a wanted felon.
- Assisted Parole in locating a parolee at large (PAL) known for burglary. Felon was taken into custody.
- GPS tracker utilized to focus on stolen property. Tracker was placed on a bicycle. Shortly after the bicycle was placed, the bicycle was on the move. A subject was quickly located was cited for possession of the stolen bicycle.
