FATAL VEHICLE FIRE CLAIMS THE LIFE OF PLACERVILLE MAN

Placerville, CA – A Placerville man died after being involved in a single vehicle collision at the intersection of Madrone Court and Sarden Drive.

On Wednesday August 12th, 2020 at approximately 11:03 PM, Placerville Police Officers responded to assist personnel from El Dorado County Fire with vehicle fire at 1012 Sarden Drive. The vehicle was found to be occupied by a single occupant.

The occupant was identified as 75 year old Lee Fisher. Mr. Fisher was pronounced deceased at the scene of the collision.

A preliminary investigation determined that the fire was the result of a single vehicle collision.

The collision and subsequent vehicle fire are still under investigation, but drugs or alcohol are not suspected as a contributing factor in the collision.
