PLACERVILLE MAN ARRESTED FOR BURGLARY AND RESISTING ARREST

Placerville, CA – On Monday September 6, 2021 at 12:41 AM, our officers were out patrolling the city when broken glass and debris were located in the roadway in front of 696 Main Street. The officer that made the discovery exited his patrol vehicle to investigate. While investigating, the sound of glass breaking was heard coming from inside the building at 696 Main Street and a male subject, later identified as 30 year old Brian Pohler who is a transient with multiple contacts throughout the county, was seen inside the dwelling.

Verbal contact was made with Pohler by Placerville Police Officers. Upon seeing the police, Pohler fled to an exit, but he was met by the officer. Pohler was holding either a wooden or metal pole and proceeded to barricade himself inside the building.

Placerville Police K9 Jupp and his handler were called to the scene to assist. Based on the fact that Pohler had barricaded himself and was armed with a wooden or metal pole K9 Jupp was deployed inside the building.

K9 Jupp searched the inside of the building and located Pohler. K9 Jupp preformed an apprehension via a bite and Pohler was taken into custody by officers without further incident. Pohler was brought to Marshall Hospital to receive medical treatment from the dog bite and other injuries from the broken glass on the ground inside the building.

Pohler was medically cleared and booked at the El Dorado County jail for burglary and resisting arrest, where he was being held without bail.
