## PLACERVILLE WOMAN ASSAULTS CITIZEN ON MAIN STREET

**Placerville, CA** – Melanie Eissler, 47 years old was arrested for felony battery on a female citizen on Main Street.

Placerville Police Officers responded to a report of a female that had assaulted another female at 681 Main Street on October 4, 2020 at 7:34 am. Eissler was reportedly carrying a metal pole and may have used the pole to assault the citizen.

Placerville Police Officers immediately began searching the area for the person responsible. Eissler was located leaving the area. Eissler was no longer in possession of a metal pole when contacted and she did not resist officers when detained.

Eissler was positively identified as the assailant by the victim. Eissler is on active parole for felony battery, and Eissler has previous arrests and convictions for similar attacks. Eissler was arrested by Placerville Police Officers for felony battery and for a parole violation.

The victim sustained a moderate injury to the back of her head and the Placerville PD wishes her a speedy recovery.

Eissler was booked into the El Dorado County jail for felony battery and a parole violation. The parole violation is a no bail violation.
