



**Proclamation of the City Council of the City of Placerville
Recognizing June 15 – 18, 2017, as El Dorado County Fair Week**

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair is a vital part of our community since the first Fair in 1859, offering an opportunity to showcase the myriad talents and industry of our citizens of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair honors our Agricultural industry which creates an estimated annual crop production of almost \$59 million, with Apples being our leading crop with 16.8 million, livestock 2nd in crop production, 10.9 million, with the wine grapes coming in 4th with 8 million; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 theme for the Fair is, “Ribbons and Rides”; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair continues to encourage participation and recognition of the diverse accomplishments of the County’s youth through an innovative partnership of the El Dorado County Office of Education, Future Farmers of America, University of California Cooperative Extension and the Fair Association; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair enriches the public’s knowledge of the world around them through educational exhibits such as the County Museum, Master Food Preservers, the Jr. Livestock Auction, and Ag related Featured Booths; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair fosters increased cultural awareness and appreciation of the arts by providing a venue for the exhibition of dance, music, art, and photography,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby resolve and determine as follows:

All citizens are urged to participate in the many activities offered at this year’s “Ribbons and Rides” fair at 100 Placerville Drive, on June 15th through Father’s Day, June 18th; the City Council extends its thanks to the many volunteers whose dedication is an essential part of the success of our annual County Fair; and the City of Placerville extends their best wishes to the Board of Directors and staff for another successful El Dorado County Fair.
