

A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE CONGRATULATING AND COMMEMORATING THE EL DORADO CHAPTER, NATIONAL SOCIETY DAUGHTERS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION FOR FORTY YEARS OF SERVICE TO OUR COMMUNITY

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution has annually participated in decorating Christmas trees along Highway 50; and

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution has offered essay contests for DAR Good Citizen and American History to school-aged children every year since 1978; and

WHEREAS: In 2012, the El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution has placed a marker on the Historic Fausel House; and

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution participated in the Placerville "National Night Out" event in 2015, 2016 and 2017; and

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution planted the Johnny Appleseed Tree at O'Halloran's Apple Acres in Apple Hill; and

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution provides food, clothing, tents and other necessary items to Placerville veterans who cannot afford them; and

WHEREAS: The El Dorado Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution has provided food, clothing, and other necessary items to students at Union Mine High School who cannot afford them;
