



**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
DECLARING OCTOBER 6th, 2020, AS
NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2020**

- WHEREAS:** The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique, nationwide “lights on” campaign and celebration against crime, drug and violence on October 6th, 2020 entitled, “National Night Out”; and
- WHEREAS:** The “37th Annual National Night Out” provides a unique opportunity for the City of Placerville to join forces and socially distance with 38 million people and over 16,000 communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases in promoting cooperative, police-community crime prevention efforts; and
- WHEREAS:** The City Council plays a vital role in assisting the Placerville Police Department through joint crime, drug and violence prevention efforts in the City of Placerville and is supporting “National Night Out 2020” locally; and
