

A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DECLARING AUGUST 3rd, 2021, AS NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2021

WHEREAS: The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique,

on August 3rd, 2021 entitled, "National Night Out"; and

WHEREAS: The "38th Annual National Night Out" provides a unique opportunity for the City

of Placerville to join forces with 38 million people and over 16,000 communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases in promoting

cooperative, police-community crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS: The City Council plays a vital role in assisting the Placerville Police Department

through joint crime, drug and violence prevention efforts in the City of Placerville
