- **WHEREAS:** Images of Hope El Dorado has hosted the Pink in the Night Awareness Campaign throughout the month of October, in conjunction with National Breast Cancer Awareness Month since 2013; and
- WHEREAS: Images of Hope's mission is to create opportunities where cancer patients, their family members, teachers and community can come participate in all aspects of the arts and foster an environment where creativity can flourish with Hope-Healing-Here, and serves all El Dorado County community members touched by cancer; and
