WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair honors our Agricultural industry which creates an estimated annual crop production of \$72.2 million, with apples being our leading crop with \$22. million, livestock at \$10. million, and wine grapes coming in as the third leading drop at \$9.6 million; and
