



**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PLACERVILLE RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF JUNE 2023  
AS LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, QUEER, INTERSEX  
AND ASEXUAL (LGBTQIA+) PRIDE MONTH**

**WHEREAS:** for more than two centuries, the founding principles and ideals of American life have included liberty, equality, freedom of expression, and the pursuit of happiness, which are intended to apply to everyone; and

**WHEREAS:** Marsha P. Johnson, a prominent leader of LGBTQIA+ Pride, proclaimed "no pride for some of us without liberation for all of us," inspiring a commitment to inclusivity, compassion, and mutual aid in support of these ideals; and

**WHEREAS:** equality of opportunity and freedom from discrimination are fundamental to supporting joy, personal fulfillment, and economic success; and

**WHEREAS:** The City of Placerville celebrates the American values of liberty, equality, freedom of expression and the pursuit of happiness and recognizes the importance of its residents, visitors, and employees to safely express their multifaceted identities which enrich our communities:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby recognize June 2023, as LGBTQIA+ Pride Month and honors all efforts that provide opportunities for a life free from discrimination and prejudice and in support of equality and the pursuit of happiness.
