

## A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE RECOGNIZING RAY BOSNICH FOR 38 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE PLACERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS,** Ray Bosnich began his service to the City of Placerville July 22, 1979, when he was hired as a Police Officer of the Placerville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Ray had previously served as a Deputy Sheriff in Marin County from 1968 to 1969 and a San Francisco Police Officer from 1969 to 1979; and

**WHEREAS,** before his law enforcement career, Ray had served in the United States Army from 1965 to 1969, to include service in the Republic of Vietnam; and

**WHEREAS,** while employed in Placerville, Ray quickly gained the confidence and respect of the department and community. Ray was promoted to Detective on July 1, 1984, and on November 16, 1984, Ray was promoted to Sergeant, a rank he held until his honorable retirement as a full-time officer on October 31, 2001; and

**WHEREAS,** Ray, who still had a desire to continue to serve his community, returned to work parttime for the Placerville Police Department on July 31, 2007, as a Police Services Assistant working in the front office assisting with records and fingerprinting; and

WHEREAS, Ray has touched countless lives and is a beloved member of the Police Department for nearly four decades, and

**WHEREAS,** Ray is retiring from the City of Placerville after working 16 years as a Police Services Assistant and 22 years as a full-time Police Officer, totaling 38 years of service to the community of Placerville:

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Michael Nash Saragosa, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Placerville, State of California, urge all citizens to join me in recognizing Ray Bosnich for his tireless and meaningful services to our community, extending our appreciation for the 38 years of public service, and further extending our best wishes in all his future endeavors.
