

A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF JUNE 2025 AS LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, QUEER, INTERSEX AND ASEXUAL (LGBTQIA+) PRIDE MONTH

WHEREAS: Marsha P. Johnson, a prominent leader of LGBTQIA+

WHEREAS: Equality of opportunity and freedom from discrimination

are fundamental to supporting joy, personal fulfillment, and

liberty, equality, freedom of expression and the pursuit of happiness, and recognizes the importance of its residents, visitors, and employees to safely express their multifaceted
