

**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PLACERVILLE RECOGNIZING THE DEDICATED SERVICE AND
RETIREMENT OF DAVID R. WARREN**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Placerville pauses to honor and recognize David R. Warren upon his retirement on May 9, 2026, celebrating a distinguished career of public service defined by integrity, fiscal expertise, and an unwavering commitment to our community; and

WHEREAS, Dave began his journey with the City in 1994 as an Accounting Assistant I, quickly earning a promotion to Accounting Assistant II just one month later; and though he briefly served as the Chief Fiscal Officer for the Gold Trail Union School District, he returned to the City in 2002, beginning an aggregate twenty-three-year legacy of leadership; and

WHEREAS, Dave's professional ascent from Assistant Finance Director to Finance Director in 2004, and later to Assistant City Manager/Director of Finance in 2018, served as the bedrock of the City's fiscal stability, culminating in his unanimous selection by the City Council to serve as City Manager in October 2025; and

WHEREAS, as a proud Sacramento State alumnus and member of the Sac State Accountancy Alumni, Dave brought technical precision to the City's complex finances, notably serving as the key staff lead for the Measures H and L Sales Tax Committee, providing the transparency and oversight necessary for critical street, water, and sewer infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Dave was instrumental in the stewardship of Measure J, the voter-approved initiative for peace officer safety, ensuring that our police department remained equipped and supported to protect the citizens of Placerville; and

WHEREAS, for over two decades, Dave served as a trusted and steady resource for the City Council, providing the expert financial analysis and institutional wisdom that informed years of council policy and sound governance; and

WHEREAS, Dave's dedication to the community extended far beyond the walls of City Hall, notably serving for eight years as the Finance Treasurer for the High Sierra Soccer League, where he volunteered his professional talents to support local youth sports and ensure a positive environment for the region's young athletes; and;

WHEREAS, throughout his tenure, Dave has been a constant presence in the pages of the *Mountain Democrat* as the reliable voice of the City's finances, earning the respect of his colleagues, his peers, and the citizens of the historic foothill community he calls home.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby extend its deepest gratitude and highest commendation to David R. Warren for his twenty-three years of exemplary service. We congratulate him on his retirement and wish him, his wife Julie, and their three sons, Nick, Landen, and Jack much happiness as Dave trades the city budget for the great outdoors.
