



**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
PLACERVILLE DECLARING THE WEEK OF APRIL 12<sup>TH</sup> THROUGH THE 18<sup>TH</sup> ,  
2026, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK**

**WHEREAS:** Emergencies can occur at any time that require Police, Fire, or Emergency Medical services; and

**WHEREAS:** When an emergency occurs, the prompt response of Police Officers, Firefighters and Paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

**WHEREAS:** The safety of our first responders is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone into the Placerville Police Department communications center; and

**WHEREAS:** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

**WHEREAS:** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our Police Officers by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS:** Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Placerville Police Department have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and

**WHEREAS:** Each Dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year:

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Placerville declares the week of April 12<sup>th</sup> through the 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026, as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Placerville, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our City and citizens safe.
