



**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DECLARING AUGUST 4TH, 2026 AS
NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2026**

- WHEREAS:** The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique, nationwide “lights on” campaign and celebration against crime, drug and violence on August 4th, 2026 entitled, National Night Out; and
- WHEREAS:** National Night Out provides a unique opportunity for the City of Placerville to join forces with 38 million people and over 16,000 communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases in promoting cooperative, police-community crime prevention efforts; and
- WHEREAS:** The City Council plays a vital role in assisting the Placerville Police Department through joint crime, drug and violence prevention efforts in the City of Placerville and is supporting National Night Out 2026 locally; and
- WHEREAS:** It is essential that all citizens of the City of Placerville be aware of the importance of crime prevention programs and impact that their participation can have on reducing crime, drugs, and violence in Placerville; and
