This Addendum is issued to the Thompson Way Repaving Project – Phase 2. Submit proposals for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this Addendum. The revisions declared in this Addendum are essential parts of the Contract.

Bidders are also directed to sign this Addendum as acknowledged, and attach the complete, signed Addendum to the Proposal.

The following responses to questions asked to date:

Question No. 1: Can Page P-11 "Bidder's List of Subcontractors (DBE and Non-DBE)" be deleted from the required proposal forms? Page P-6 will be utilized for the Subcontractor Listing since there are no DBE requirements?

Answer: Per Spec Section 2-1.33A, The "Bidder's List of Subcontractors (DBE & Non-DBE)" form is required to be submitted with the bid or may be emailed within 24 hours after the bid opening. The "Subcontractor Listing" form on page P-6 must be submitted with the bid package.

Question No. 2: With 3 separate CIP numbers, will there have to be 3 separate WPCPs?

Answer: No, there should only be one WPCP prepared and submitted for the whole project, but the total cost should be divided across all 3 project's bid item 3.

Question No. 3: Is there a DBE goal or requirement for this project?

Answer: No, there is no DBE requirement whatsoever for this project.

Question No. 4: Are there any grade changes to the road profile for this project?

Answer: No. Generally, the project intends to match existing grades, but there could be areas where crown or superelevation are added or reduced per the design cross-sections as compared to existing conditions.

Question No. 5: Thompson Way: Instead of CIPP lining, could the contractor remove and replace the 210 LF of 12-inch storm drain pipe?

Answer: Yes. We will revise the bid form so that Line Item 20 may be CIPP lining or R&R with 12-inch SDR-26.

Question No. 6: Thompson Way: What size are the specific trees that are scheduled for removal on Thompson Way?

Answer: All 3 trees are located along the north side of the road at 1055 Thompson Way and vary in diameter between 18-inch and 24-inch. We will add a note to Bid Item 6 that trees to be removed will range from 18-inch to 24-inch.

Question No. 7: Sheridan Street: Is the large cedar located at 3132 Sheridan Street to be removed with this project?

Answer: The cedar tree at 3132 Sheridan Street shall be protected in place and is not to be removed as part of this project. However, root conflicts are anticipated. The City will allow the contractor to cut roots that are determined to be in-conflict, if they are 2-inches in diameter or smaller, under the observation of the city construction inspector. Bid Item 4 will be revised to say "Arborist Services" which should include the removal of large roots and tree pruning if necessary. Tree professional (ISA Certified Arborist or equivalent) should be listed as a sub-contractor on page P-6 of the bid package.

Question No. 8: Thompson Way: What does the detectable warning surface bid item include?

Answer: Bid Item #3 – Detectable Warning Surface/Truncated Domes – Only refers to the detectable warning surface proposed on Sheet C06, Keynote 19, and includes the 6-inch concrete collar, grading and AC conform for the landing as shown in the detail. This bid item is not associated with the new ADA ramp at the S/E corner of Cedar Ravine which is Bid Item #8.

Question No. 9: Will a staging area be provided?

Answer: Per Section 4-1.13A: “The Contractor must locate and negotiate terms of use for their staging area.” The staging area will not be provided by the City.

The following changes are made to the project plans, Notice to Bidders, Special Provisions, Proposal, and contract as part of this addendum:

Item No. 1: Revise the following on bid forms:

- Thompson Way Bid Item 6: Add the words “- DBH 18” TO 24””
- Thompson Way Bid Item 17: Change Quantity to 4.
- Thompson Way Bid Item 20: Add the words “OR R&R WITH 12” SD PVC-SDR 26”
- Sheridan Street Bid Item 4: Replace with the words “ARBORIST SERVICES” and change units to Lump Sum.

Item No. 2: Replace Keynote 26 on Sheet C08 with the following:

Existing Tree Roots. Contractor must expose existing roots prior to the start of cold plane operations. In-conflict roots 2-inches diameter or less may be cut by the contractor under the observation of the city construction inspector. Roots greater than 2-inches must be cut by a certified tree professional under the direction of a licensed arborist. Roots should be cut back at least 6-inches from the edge of pavement or as recommended by the Arborist.

Item No. 3: Replace the second sentence from the second paragraph of Section 77-1.03A(7) with the following:

For damaged or severed root systems, or root conflicts greater than 2-inches in diameter, roots shall be trimmed by a tree professional (ISA Certified Arborist or equivalent) under the direction of a licensed arborist, and trees shall be trimmed by a tree professional under the direction of the licensed arborist to compensate for the decreased root system.

Item No. 4: Append Division IV SUBBASES AND BASES; Section 26 AGGREGATE BASES of the Special Provisions; the second paragraph of section 26-1.02A with the following:

Unless otherwise noted on the plans or in these special provisions, aggregate used for Class 2 AB shall be $\frac{3}{4}$ " and must comply with the $\frac{3}{4}$ " maximum gradation in Section 26-1.02B.

Recycled AB and/or appropriately ground and blended material generated from Remove Base and Surfacing or Cold Plane activities can be used in lieu of Class 2 AB under the minor concrete items, as shoulder backing, and as approved by the Engineer.

If, during subgrade preparation, additional material is required to achieve the required grade or cross section, the Contractor shall incorporate asphalt concrete grindings generated from this project into the existing subgrade as part of the scarification operation.

Grindings shall be uniformly blended into the top 12 inches of subgrade and shall not exceed 25 percent by volume of the mixed material unless otherwise approved by the Engineer. Oversized chunks shall be removed.

The resulting mixture shall be moisture conditioned, compacted to the specified density, and tested in accordance with the project specifications.

Use of grindings under this section shall not reduce or eliminate the required thickness of aggregate base or asphalt concrete shown on the plans.

The work for which this Proposal is submitted is for the construction in accordance with these Contract Documents (including the payment of not less than the State general prevailing wage rates or Federal minimum wage rates set forth herein), the Project Plans described below, including any addenda thereto, the Contract annexed hereto, and also in accordance with the California Department of Transportation Standard Plans and Standard Specifications, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates in effect on the date the work is accomplished, and in accordance with the General Prevailing Wage rates. The Project Plans and Contract Documents for the work to be done are entitled:

Bids are to be submitted for the entire work, including additive alternates, if any. The amount of the bid for comparison purposes will be the total of all the base and optional bid items.

The Bidder shall set forth for each unit basis item of work a unit price and a total for the item, and for each lump sum item a total for the item, all in clearly legible figures in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Item Total" column shall be the product of the unit price bid and the estimate quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for a unit basis item, the unit price shall prevail, except as provided in (a) or (b), as follows:

- (a) If the amount set forth as a unit price is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, or is the same as the amount as the entry in the item total column, then the amount set forth in the total column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimate quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price.
- (b) (Decimal Errors) If the product of the entered unit price and the estimated quantity is exactly off by a factor of ten, one hundred, etc., or one-tenth, or one-hundredth, etc., from the entered total, the discrepancy will be resolved by using the entered unit price or item total, whichever most closely approximates percentage wise the unit price or item total in the Department's Final Estimate of Cost.

If this Proposal is accepted and the undersigned Bidder shall fail to enter into the Contract and furnish the two bonds in the sums required by the State Contract Act, with surety satisfaction to the City of Placerville within eight days, not including Sundays and legal holidays, after the bidder has received notice from the City of Placerville that the Contract has been awarded, the City of Placerville may, at its option, determine that the Bidder has abandoned the Contract, and thereupon this Proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void and the forfeiture of such security accompanying this Proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the City of Placerville.

The undersigned, as Bidder, declares under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the only persons or parties interested in this Proposal, as principals, are those named herein; that this Proposal is made without collusion with any other person, firm, or corporation; that he has carefully examined the location of the proposed work, the annexed proposed form of Contract, and the Plans therein referred to; and he proposes, and agrees if this Proposal is accepted, that he will contract with the City of Placerville, in the form of the copy of the Contract annexed hereto, to provide all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, and to do all the work and furnish all the materials specified in the Contract, in the manner and time therein prescribed, and according to the requirements of the Engineer as therein set forth, and that he will take in full payment therefore the following item prices, to wit:
