### Position Description

Position: Volunteer Junior Swim Aide

Description: Volunteer Junior Swim Aides assist with our swimming lesson program, working alongside instructors to provide high-quality swimming lessons to children of all ages. If you are looking to gain some teaching experience or hope to become a swim instructor one day, you are encouraged to apply. Interviews will be conducted, and successful applicants will be invited to attend the training class in June.

Dates Needed:  On-Going  Other: June – Early August

Responsibilities: Assist instructor's with skill demonstration, corrective feedback, positive reinforcement, organize equipment, and supervise swimmers.

Qualifications: Applicants must be able to swim 25 yards freestyle and be able to commit to at least 2 full sessions of either morning or evening swimming lessons. Sessions are 1 or 2 weeks in length. Applicants must be a minimum 13 years of age and demonstrate maturity and the ability to take on swim aide responsibilities. Applicants must also attend a 2-hour training session in early June.
