PHASE 1a

Persons at risk of exposure to SARS-CoV-2 through their work in any role in direct health care or long-term care settings and residents of long term care facilities.

Vaccinating NOW

JANUARY 2021

Tier 1

- ☒ Acute care, psychiatric and correctional facility hospital staff
- ☒ Staff at skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, and similar settings for older or medically vulnerable individuals
- ☒ Residents in long-term care settings
- ☒ Paramedics, EMTs, and others providing emergency medical services
- ☒ Staff at dialysis centers

Vaccinating NOW

Tier 2

- ☒ Intermediate care facilities for persons who need non-continuous nursing supervision and supportive care
- ☒ Home health care and in-home supportive service staff
- ☒ Community health workers, including promotoras
- ☒ Public Health field staff medical services
- ☒ Staff at Primary care clinics, including federally qualified health centers, rural health centers, correctional facility clinics, and urgent care clinics

Vaccinating NOW

Tier 3

- ☒ Staff at specialty clinics
- ☒ Laboratory workers
- ☒ Dental and other oral health clinic staff
- ☒ Pharmacy staff not working in settings at higher tiers

PHASE 1b Vaccinating NEXT

Tier 1

- ☐ Persons aged 75 years and older
- ☐ Frontline essential workers, including education, law enforcement, food and agriculture, emergency services

Tier 2

- ☐ Persons aged 65-74 years of age
- ☐ Frontline essential workers, including manufacturing, transportation, facilities and services
- ☐ Congregate settings including incarcerated and people experiencing homelessness
