**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
PLACERVILLE REQUESTING \$20,000 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM  
EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2018/2019 FISCAL YEAR TO HELP OFFSET  
SOME OF THE OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING A  
COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM AT THE CITY AQUATICS CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that over 70% of the people who attend the City of Placerville Aquatics Center reside out-side the City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City requests \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has an opportunity to request additional funding from El Dorado County for emergency repairs to the facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby requests \$20,000 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year to help offset some of the operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive program at the City Aquatics Center.
