A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DECLARING CERTAIN CITY TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT SURPLUS PROPERTY AND APPROVING SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER

WHEREAS, Until July 2008 the Meagher House, at Gold Bug Park, was the workshop and storage site for the City's Park Maintenance Division; and

WHEREAS, the Park staff has relocated and taken all useful items out of the Meagher House and moved them to the City's Corporation Yard leaving behind miscellaneous items; and

WHEREAS, the City has accumulated a number of tools and equipment that have little or no value in their current state and should be sold to the highest bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to have the highest bidder remove all tools and equipment at no expense to the City; and

WHEREAS, in the event the City does not receive a bid, City staff will dispose of any unsold surplus property to either Snowline Hospice or El Dorado Disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Services will execute all necessary documents for the sale or disposal of surplus property; and

WHEREAS, proceeds from the sale of surplus property will be deposited into the Gold Bug Park Reserve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville:

- 1. Declares that the tools and equipment shown on Attachment "A" as surplus property with an estimated sale value of \$2,155; and
- 2. Authorizes the Director of Community Services to execute the sale of the surplus property to the highest responsible bidder; and
- 3. Authorizes City staff to dispose of any unsold surplus property to either Snowline Hospice or El Dorado Disposal; and
- 4. Authorizes the Director of Community Services to execute all necessary documents for the sale or disposal of surplus property; and
- 5. Authorizes all proceeds from the sale of surplus property to be deposited into the Gold Bug Parks Reserve for future park improvements.
